- 3) Finish among the Top 20 in the final 1995-96 Rolex Collegiate Singles Rankings, administered by the ITA.

DOUBLES (denoted by 'D')

- 1) Be seeded in the NCAA doubles tournament (either Nos. 1-4 or 5-8 alphabetical), OR
- 2) Advance to the quarterfinals (win two matches) at the NCAA doubles tournament, OR
- 3) Finish among the Top 10 in the final 1995-96 Rolex Collegiate Doubles Rankings, administered by the ITA.

Note: Must also be in good standing with the ITA Ethics & Infractions Committee.
