Selection Criteria

The singles and doubles champions from each USTA/ITA Regional Championship (Men's & Women's) will earn an automatic berth into the USTA/ITA National Indoor Intercollegiate Championships. The singles and doubles Super Bowl Champions from the USTA/ITA National Small College Championships will receive an automatic berth as well.

A singles player who reaches the quarterfinals at the ITA All-American Championships will receive an automatic berth. For doubles, an automatic berth will be given to the finalists of the ITA All-American Championships.

Changes from the December 2010 Operating Committee Meeting: Last year's USTA/ITA National Indoor Intercollegiate Champions will not receive automatic entry. In singles, the winner of the 2011 ITA All-American Championships consolation draw will be granted a berth. As for doubles, both ITA All-American Finalists as well as the Consolation Champions will be granted entry. Two at-large spots in the doubles draw have also been added.

The breakdown of the draw is below:

Men's Criteria:

Singles: (32 draw)

- 12 Regional Champions
- 8 All-American Quarterfinalists
- 1 All-American Consolation Winner
- 1 Super Bowl Champion
- 1 Host Wildcard
- 1 USTA Wildcard
- 2 ITA Wildcards
- 6 At-Large

Doubles: (20 draw)

- 12 Regional Champions
- 2 All-American Finalists
- 1 All-American Consolation Winner
- 1 Super Bowl Champion
- 1 Host Wildcard
- 1 USTA Wildcard
- 2 At-Large

Men's At-Large Criteria: To be considered for an at-large selection in men's singles, a player must have reached at least the quarterfinals of a Division I USTA/ITA Regional Championship. From this pool, the National Tournament Committee will select singles players in order of preseason Campbell/ITA national ranking (once the ranking lists has been exhausted, the committee will make the selection based on fall results/performance).

To be considered for an at-large selection in men's doubles, a team must have reached at least the semifinals of a Division I USTA/ITA Regional Championship. From this pool, the National Tournament Committee will select doubles teams based on fall results and preseason rankings.

Women's Criteria:

Singles: (32 draw)

- 12 Regional Champions
- 8 All-American Quarterfinalists
- 1 All-American Consolation Winner
- 1 Super Bowl Champion
- 1 Host Wildcard
- 1 USTA Wildcard
- 1 ITA Wildcard
- 7 At-Large

Doubles: (20 draw)

- 12 Regional Champions
- 2 All-American Finalists
- 1 All-American Consolation Winner
- 1 Super Bowl Champion
- 1 Host Wildcard
- 1 USTA Wildcard
- 2 At-Large

Women's At-Large Criteria: To be considered for an at-large selection in women's singles, a player must have played in a Division I USTA/ITA Regional Championship. Players who reached at least the quarterfinals of a Division I USTA/ITA Regional Championship and who are ranked in the top 15 of the Campbell/ITA preseason rankings will automatically receive an at-large spot. Once the top 15 ranking list has been exhausted, the committee will make the remaining at-large selections based on fall results/performance.

To be considered for an at-large selection in women's doubles, a team must have reached at least the semifinals of a Division I USTA/ITA Regional Championship. From this pool, the National Tournament Committee will select doubles teams based on fall results and preseason rankings.

Coaches who do not submit their at-large application(s) before the deadline will NOT have their players considered for an at-large spot.
